

Bishop Bätzing takes stock at the end of the German bishops'ad Limina visit to Rome

At a press conference this morning (19 November 2022), the President of the German Bishops' Conference, Bishop Dr Georg Bätzing, took stock of the German bishops' ad Limina visit. Since Monday, the members of the German Bishops' Conference have met the Pope and numerous representatives of the Roman Curia and celebrated masses. In addition to Eucharistic celebrations in four Papal basilicas, St. Peter's, Santa Maria Maggiore, San Paolo fuori le mura and San Giovanni in Laterano, the bishops had meetings in the dicasteries, the Secretariat of State and other institutions of the Holy See:

- the Dicastery for Promoting Integral Human Development
- the Dicastery for Legislative Texts
- the Dicastery for Communication
- the General Secretariat of the Synod of Bishops
- the Pontifical Commission for the Protection of Minors

There were also meetings at the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany at the Holy See, in the Community of Sant'Egidio and at the College of Santa Maria dell'Anima.
